Fire of Love: Scott Hahn Reflects on the Third Sunday of Easter

There are two places in Scripture where the curious detail of a “charcoal fire” is mentioned.

One is in today’s Gospel, where the Apostles return from fishing to find bread and fish warming on the fire.

The other is in the scene in the High Priest’s courtyard on Holy Thursday, where Peter and some guards and slaves warm themselves while Jesus is being interrogated inside.

At the first fire, Peter denied knowing Jesus three times, as Jesus had predicted.

Today’s charcoal fire becomes the scene of Peter’s repentance, as three times Jesus asks him to make a profession of love. Jesus’ thrice repeated command “feed My sheep” shows that Peter is being appointed as the shepherd of the Lord’s entire flock, the head of His Church.

Jesus’ question: “Do you love me more than these?” is a pointed reminder of Peter’s pledge to lay down his life for Jesus, even if the other Apostles might weaken.

Jesus then explains just what Peter’s love and leadership will require, foretelling Peter’s death by crucifixion (“you will stretch out your hands”).

Before His own death, Jesus had warned the Apostles that they would be hated as He was hated, that they would suffer as He suffered.

We see the beginnings of that persecution in today’s First Reading. Flogged as Jesus was, the Apostles nonetheless leave “rejoicing that they have been found worthy to suffer.”

Their joy is based on their faith that God will change their “mourning into dancing,” as we sing in today’s Psalm. By their sufferings, the know, they will be counted worthy to stand in heaven before “the Lamb that was slain,” a scene glimpsed in today’s Second Reading.

Fuego de amor: Scott Hahn reflexiona sobre el tercer domingo de Pascua

Hay dos lugares en las Escrituras donde se menciona el curioso detalle de una “fogata de carbón”.

Uno es en el Evangelio de hoy, donde los Apóstoles regresan de pescar y encuentran pan y pescado calentándose en el fuego.

El otro es en la escena del patio del Sumo Sacerdote, la noche del Jueves Santo, donde Pedro y algunos guardias y sirvientes se calientan mientras Jesús está siendo interrogado adentro.

En la primera fogata, Pedro negó conocer a Jesús tres veces, tal como Jesús lo había predicho.

La fogata de carbón de hoy se convierte en el escenario del arrepentimiento de Pedro, ya que tres veces Jesús le pide que haga una profesión de amor. El mandato repetido tres veces de Jesús: “Apacienta mis ovejas”, muestra que Pedro está siendo designado como el pastor del rebaño del Señor, la cabeza de Su Iglesia.

La pregunta de Jesús: “¿Me amas más que estos?” es un recordatorio claro de la promesa de Pedro de dar su vida por Jesús, incluso si los otros Apóstoles se debilitaban.

Jesús luego le explica lo que su amor y liderazgo requerirán, prediciendo la muerte de Pedro por crucifixión (“extenderás los brazos”).

Antes de su propia muerte, Jesús había advertido a los Apóstoles que serían odiados como Él fue odiado, que sufrirían como Él sufrió.

Vemos los comienzos de esa persecución en la Primera Lectura de hoy. Azotados como Jesús, los Apóstoles, sin embargo, se marchan “gozosos de haber sido considerados dignos de sufrir”.

Su alegría se basa en su fe en que Dios cambiará su “lamento en danza”, como cantamos en el Salmo de hoy. Por sus sufrimientos, saben que serán considerados dignos de estar en el cielo ante “el Cordero que fue inmolado”, una escena vislumbrada en la Segunda Lectura de hoy.


